**PER: MAKLUMAN PERGERAKAN PELAJAR UNTUK KEMASUKAN OKTOBER 2021**

Dengan segala hormatnya perkara di atas adalah dirujuk. GUC membenarkan pelajar untuk pulang semula ke kampus secara berperingkat bermula pada 15 Oktober 2021. Bagi mengekalkan keselamatan kampus daripada wabak COVID19, pembelajaran akan dilangsungkan secara hibrid dan mengikut SOP yang telah ditetapkan.

Berikut adalah syarat kemasukan pelajar ke kampus yang telah ditetapkan oleh Kementerian Pengajian Tinggi Malaysia:

- 1) Lengkap menerima 2 dos vaksin (Astrazeneca/Pfizer/Sinovac) dan melepasi tempoh keberkesanan selama 14 hari selepas divaksin.
- 2) Penerima suntikan dos tunggal (Johnson & Johnson/CanSino) dan melepasi tempoh keberkesanan 28 hari dari tarikh suntikan.
- 3) Keutamaan diberikan kepada pelajar yang bekeperluan untuk hadir ke kampus seperti menjalani praktikal, amali, menggunakan kemudahan makmal, klinikal, studio, bengkel, peralatan khas dan tidak mempunyai akses atau persekitaran yang kondusif untuk menjalani sesi pembelajaran.
- 4) Pelajar daripada Sarawak dan Wilayah Persekutuan Labuan diwajibkan menjalani kuarantin di lokasi yang telah ditetapkan oleh GUC
- 5) Pelajar daripada Sabah diwajibkan menjalani pemantauan sendiri melalui Aplikasi MySejahtera.
- 6) Pelajar Antarabangsa : berdaftar dengan pihak Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS) sebelum diberikan kebenaran masuk ke Malaysia oleh Jabatan Imigresen Malaysia, menjalani ujian Swab RT-PCR COVID-19 sebelum masuk ke Malaysia dan menjalani saringan kesihatan serta kuarantin di lokasi yang ditetapkan setibanya di Malaysia.

**\*\*Bagi pelajar antarabangsa yang berada di Malaysia, hanya perlu mengikut perkara 1-3.**

**NOTICE: STUDENT ADMISSION FOR OCTOBER 2021**

Referring to the matter above, The GUC allows students to return to campus in stages beginning October 15, 2021. To maintain campus safety from the COVID19 outbreak, learning will be conducted in a hybrid manner and in accordance with the SOPs that have been set.


The following are the conditions for admission of students to the campus that have been set by the Ministry of Higher Education Malaysia:

- 1) Complete receive 2 doses of vaccine (AstraZeneca/Pfizer/Sinovac) and pass the effectiveness period of 14 days after vaccination.
- 2) Recipients of single dose injections (Johnson & Johnson/CanSino) and past the effectiveness period of 28 days from the date of injection.
- 3) Priority is given to students who need to attend campus such as undergoing practical, internships, using laboratory, clinical, studio, workshop, special equipment facilities, and do not have access or a conducive environment to conduct learning sessions.
- 4) Students from Sarawak and the Federal Territory of Labuan are required to undergo quarantine at locations designated by the GUC.
- 5) Students from Sabah are required to undergo self-monitoring through the MySejahtera Application.
- 6) **For international student:** they have registered with Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS) before being given permission to enter Malaysia by the Malaysian Immigration Department, do RT-PCR COVID-19 before enter Malaysia and undergo health screening and quarantine at designated locations upon arrival in di Malaysia.

\*\* For international students who are in Malaysia, only need to follow item no 1- 3.
